EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION**

Emergencies such as snow, ice, power outages and floods can alter school schedules and affect bus transportation for students. If you are in doubt about conditions, please check the following resources to learn about potential changes to Snoqualmie Valley school schedules or bus routes:

If there is no message about Snoqualmie Valley School District #410, our schools are open on a normal schedule. When our school district makes the call for adverse weather conditions, the entire district might not be affected. The district is, therefore, divided into three geographic areas for limited transportation services: Area A, B, and C. If your Area is identified to warrant limited bus transportation, check below to see if your pick-up location has changed, and if so, direct your student/s to that new location. Occasionally, when only high elevation locations within an Area are affected, the locations will be listed by neighborhood (i.e. "Limited Transportation Area A: River Bend, Wilderness Rim, The Uplands only") on the school website at www.svsd410.org.

Potential announcements may say:

- **"Schools Closed"**... All school activities are also canceled for that day.
- **"Schools Open, One Hour Late"**... Scheduled runs, one hour late. No out-of-district transportation.
- **"Schools Open, Two Hours Late"**... Scheduled runs, two hours late. No A.M. Preschool, Encompass, AM Kindergarten, or out-of-district transportation.
- **"Schools Open, Limited Transportation"**... Shortened runs due to inclement weather or road conditions for Areas A, B or C.

AREA "A" NORTH BEND

CEDAR FALLS ROAD: No side roads serviced past entrance to River Bend and no service past entrance to Wilderness Rim.

WILDERNESS RIM: Main road only. No side street service.

468 Ave. SE & EDGEWICK ROAD: All side roads meet at Edgewick Rd. Route goes to 464 Way SE and turns around at the Y.

MIDDLE FORK ROAD: Bus will turn around at 473 Ct.

MT. SI ROAD: Pick up on main road only to Riverpoint.

FORSTER WOODS: Pick up at the main entrance.

ROCK CREEK RIDGE: Pick up at the main entrance.

THE UPLANDS: Pick up at 415th Way SE & SE 142 St.

AREA “B” SNOQUALMIE

96th ST.: Echo Lake, Leisure Time meet at entrance to 96th.

SNOQUALMIE RIDGE: Pick up on Snoqualmie Parkway

Pick up on Douglas Ave. SE to SE Carmichael

Pick up on SE Carmichael to SE Sorenson

Pick up on Fairway Ave. SE to Muir St.

Pick up on Center Blvd. SE, SE Ridge St., Eagle Lake Dr. SE

Deer Park: Pick up at Swensen Ave. and Leitz SE

Stone Ridge: Pick up at entrance and Snoqualmie Parkway

Eagle Point: Pick up at entrance and Snoqualmie Parkway

No side roads will be serviced.

HIGHLAND DRIVE & TOKUL ROAD: Pick up at the Main Line and 396 Dr. SE. Pick up at Tokul Rd. and SE 53 St. No travel to SE 47 St. and Tokul Rd.

AREA “C” FALL CITY

AMES LAKE: Pick up at NE 34 St. and NE 40 St.

No transportation around Ames Lake.

All developments along Ames Lake Rd.—Heather Knoll, Quail Creek, Amesbury, and

Broadhurst—must catch bus on Ames Lake Road and the entrance to the development.

DEVEREAU/CAMDIN PARK AREA: Pick up at Albertson’s on Redmond-Fall City Rd.

ISSAQUAH/FALL CITY ROAD: Pick up at the lower Issaquah-Fall City Rd. at the junction of SE 40 St. and Issaquah-Fall City Rd.

MONTAINE: Pick up at 278 Ave. SE and the park.

ALDERRA ESTATES: Pick up at entrance at 278 Ave. SE and Duthie Hill Rd.

SE 8th -292 AVE. NE: Pick up at Hwy. 202 and SE 8.

BLAKELY WOODS, HAWTHORN RIDGE, 290 AVE. NE, TOLT HILL ROAD: Pick up at 290 Ave. NE and Tolt Hill Rd.

FALL CITY UPLANDS: Pick up at 328 Ave. SE and SE 48 St.

LAKE ALICE: Pick up at the trail head SE 56 St. No transportation into Heathercrest.

LAKE MARIE: (356th Ave. SE) Pick up at Spring Glen Trailer Court.

RIVERVIEW MOBILE PARK: Pick up at Y stop sign.

Flooding generally affects the Snoqualmie and Fall City areas. Rerouting is possible in most of the following areas and alternate pick ups and drop offs will be established, depending on the area affected.

Most common areas affected by flooding in our school district:

- Snoqualmie: 396th (Meadowbrook Way at Trestle), Fir Street, Northern Street
- Fall City: Fish Hatchery Road, Neal Road, 324th, SE 24th, Tolt Hill Road (Carnation side), and David Powell Road

TRANSPORTATION ROAD CLOSURE PRACTICES

When road conditions are such that school buses cannot drive their assigned routes, parents need to decide to either transport their student(s) or keep them home for the day.

NOTE: Not every emergency situation can be anticipated. Occasionally, after a decision is made early in the morning, conditions that impact the safe transportation of students may change and merit an adjustment. Parents are encouraged to develop emergency plans with their children, and make sure your school has accurate contact information, in the event of an early closure.
