**If there is no message about Snoqualmie Valley School District #410, schools are open on a normal schedule.** When our school district makes the call for adverse weather conditions, the entire district might not be affected. The district is, therefore, divided into three geographic areas for limited transportation services: Area A, B, and C. If your Area is identified to warrant limited bus transportation, check below to see if your pick-up location has changed, and if so, direct your student/s to that new location. Occasionally, when only high elevation locations within an Area are affected, the locations will be listed by neighborhood (i.e. "Limited Transportation Area A: River Bend, Wilderness Rim only") on the school website at [www.svsd410.org](http://www.svsd410.org)

Potential announcements may say:

- **"Schools Closed"**... All school activities are also canceled for that day.
- **"Schools Open, One Hour Late"**... Scheduled runs, one hour late. No out-of-district transportation.
- **"Schools Open, Two Hours Late"**... Scheduled runs, two hours late. No A.M. Preschool, Encompass, AM Kindergarten, or out-of-district transportation.
- **"Schools Open, Limited Transportation"**... Shortened runs due to inclement weather or road conditions for Areas A, B or C.

#### AREA " A " NORTH BEND

**CEDAR FALLS ROAD** – No side roads serviced past River Bend and no service past Wilderness Rim. **If road closes – there will be no bus transportation on Cedar Falls Road.**

**WILDERNESS RIM** – Main road only, no side street service.

**468<sup>TH</sup> AVE. SE & EDGEWICK ROAD** – All side roads meet at Edgewick Road. Route goes to 464<sup>th</sup> Way SE and turns around at the Y.

**MIDDLE FORK ROAD** - Bus will turn around at 473<sup>rd</sup> Ct.

**MT SI ROAD** – Pick up main road to River Point.

**FORSTER WOODS** - Pick up at the main entrance.

**ROCK CREEK RIDGE** - Pick up at the main entrance.

**Uplands** - Pick up at 415th (updated 11-15-11)

## AREA " B " SNOQUALMIE

**96<sup>TH</sup> ST** - Echo Lake - meet at entrance to 96<sup>th</sup>.

### **SNOQUALMIE RIDGE** -

Pick up on Snoqualmie Parkway

Pick up on Douglas Ave. SE to SE Carmichael

Pick up on SE Carmichael to SE Sorenson

Pick up on Fairway Ave. to Muir St.

Pick up on Center Blvd. SE, SE Ridge St. to Eagle Lake Dr. SE

Deer Park: Pick up at Swensen Ave. and Leitz SE

Aster Creek & Eagle Point: Pick up at Jacobia & Hancock streets.

No side roads will be serviced.

**HIGHLAND DRIVE & TOKUL ROAD** - Pick up at the Main Line & 396<sup>th</sup> Drive SE. Pick up at Tokul Road and SE 53<sup>rd</sup> St. No travel to SE 47<sup>th</sup> St. & Tokul Road.

## AREA " C " FALL CITY

**AMES LAKE** - Pick up at NE 34<sup>th</sup> St and NE 40<sup>th</sup> St.

No transportation around Ames Lake.

All developments along Ames Lake Road – Heather Knoll, Quail Creek, Amesbury, and Broadhurst must catch bus on Ames Lake Road at the entrance to the development.

**DEVEREAU / CAMDEN PARK AREA** - Pick up at Albertson's on Redmond-Fall City Road.

**ISSAQUAH / FALL CITY ROAD** - Pick up at the lower Issaquah Fall City Road at the junction of SE 40<sup>th</sup> St & Issaquah Fall City Road.

**MONTAINE** – Pick up at 278<sup>th</sup> Ave. SE and the park.

**ALDERRA ESTATES** - Pick up at entrance at 278<sup>th</sup> Ave SE & Duthie Hill Road.

**SE 8TH – 292<sup>ND</sup> AVE NE** - Pick up at Highway 202 & SE 8<sup>th</sup>.

**BLAKELY WOODS, HAWTHORN RIDGE, 290TH AVE NE , TOLT HILL ROAD** - Pick up at 290th Ave NE & Tolt Hill Road.

**FALL CITY UPLANDS** - Pick up at 328<sup>th</sup> Ave SE & SE 48<sup>th</sup> St.

**LAKE ALICE** - Pick up at trail head SE 56<sup>th</sup> St, no transportation into Heather Crest.

**LAKE MARIE** - Pick up at Spring Glen Mobile Park.

**RIVERVIEW MOBILE PARK** - Pick up at Y stop sign.

**DAVID POWELL ROAD** - Pick up at the entrance.

→ **If there is "Limited Transportation" in the AM, there will also be "Limited Transportation" in the PM. Students will be delivered to the same location as their Limited Transportation AM pick-up location.**

**Flooding** generally affects the Snoqualmie and Fall City areas. Rerouting is possible in most of the following areas and alternate pick-ups and drop offs will be established, depending on the area affected.

Most common areas affected by flooding in our school district:

- Snoqualmie: 396th (Meadowbrook Way at Trestle), Fir Street, Northern Street
- Fall City: Fish Hatchery Road, Neal Road, 324<sup>th</sup>, SE 24<sup>th</sup>, Tolt Hill Road (Carnation side), and David Powell Road

### **TRANSPORTATION ROAD CLOSURE PRACTICES**

When road conditions are such that school buses cannot drive their assigned routes, parents need to decide to either transport their student(s) or keep them home for the day.

**NOTE:** Not every emergency situation can be anticipated. Occasionally, after a decision is made early in the morning, conditions that impact the safe transportation of students may change and merit an adjustment. Parents are encouraged to develop emergency plans with their children, and make sure your school has accurate contact information, in the event of an early closure.
