Courses that address Environmental, Behavioral, Health, School Safety, Human Resources, and Transportation issues, *SafeSchools* provides staff with an easy-to-use learning environment that effectively prepares them to handle safety crises by presenting them with real school safety issues. *SafeSchools* also effectively provides your district with a compliance management system that tracks, manages, and reports the status of your safety training for all employees.

### Why are we offering this service?

The Puget Sound Workers Compensation Trust has made [SafeSchools.com](http://SafeSchools.com) available to your district to provide an online instruction and tracking system that you can utilize at no additional cost. In other words, as a cooperative pool, we have pre-paid all of your current and future employees who will be using this system. This is a value-added benefit that is intended to help you achieve your training and compliance goals without incurring additional costs, therefore lowering the barriers to implementation. This program is not intended to replace any of your current onsite, in house, or program specific training, this training system simply allows you to have alternative choices to those trainings and make training easier to accomplish. Another value-added benefit is that offline trainings can be recorded in the online database. You can train your employees and give them "manual" credit inside the system.
