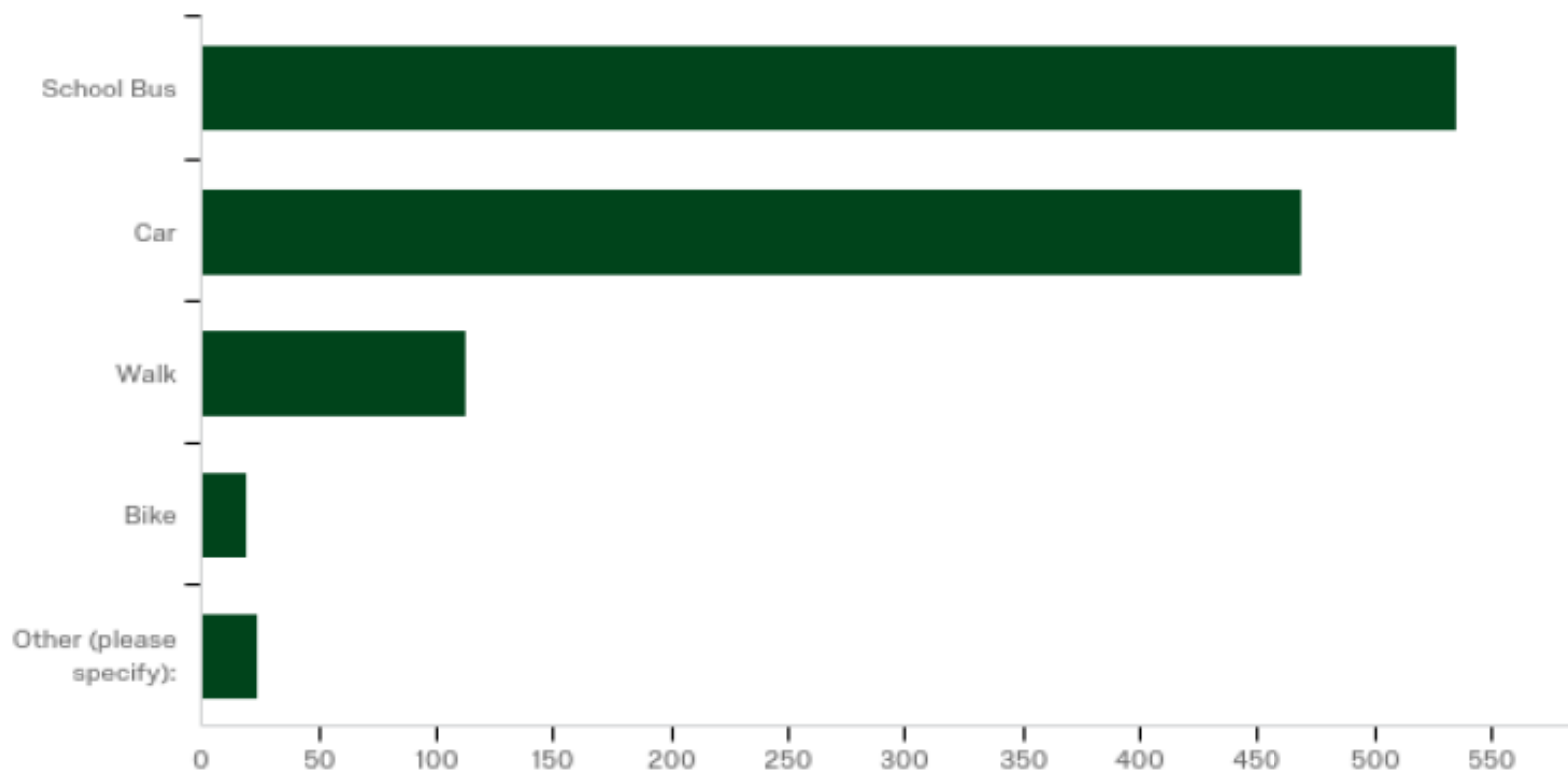

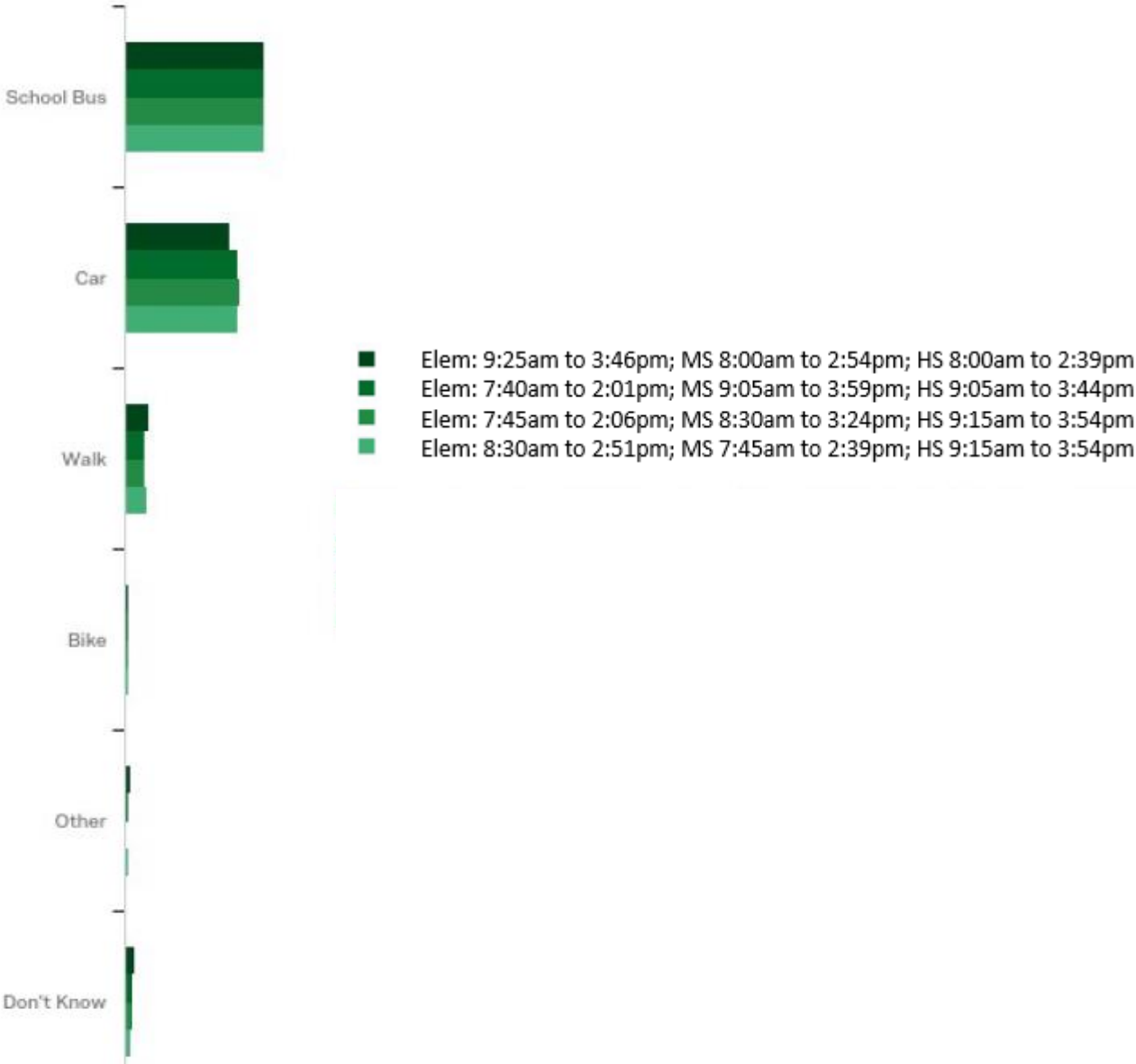

Q45 - Currently, what form of transportation does your child/children most frequently take to and from school? Select all that apply.

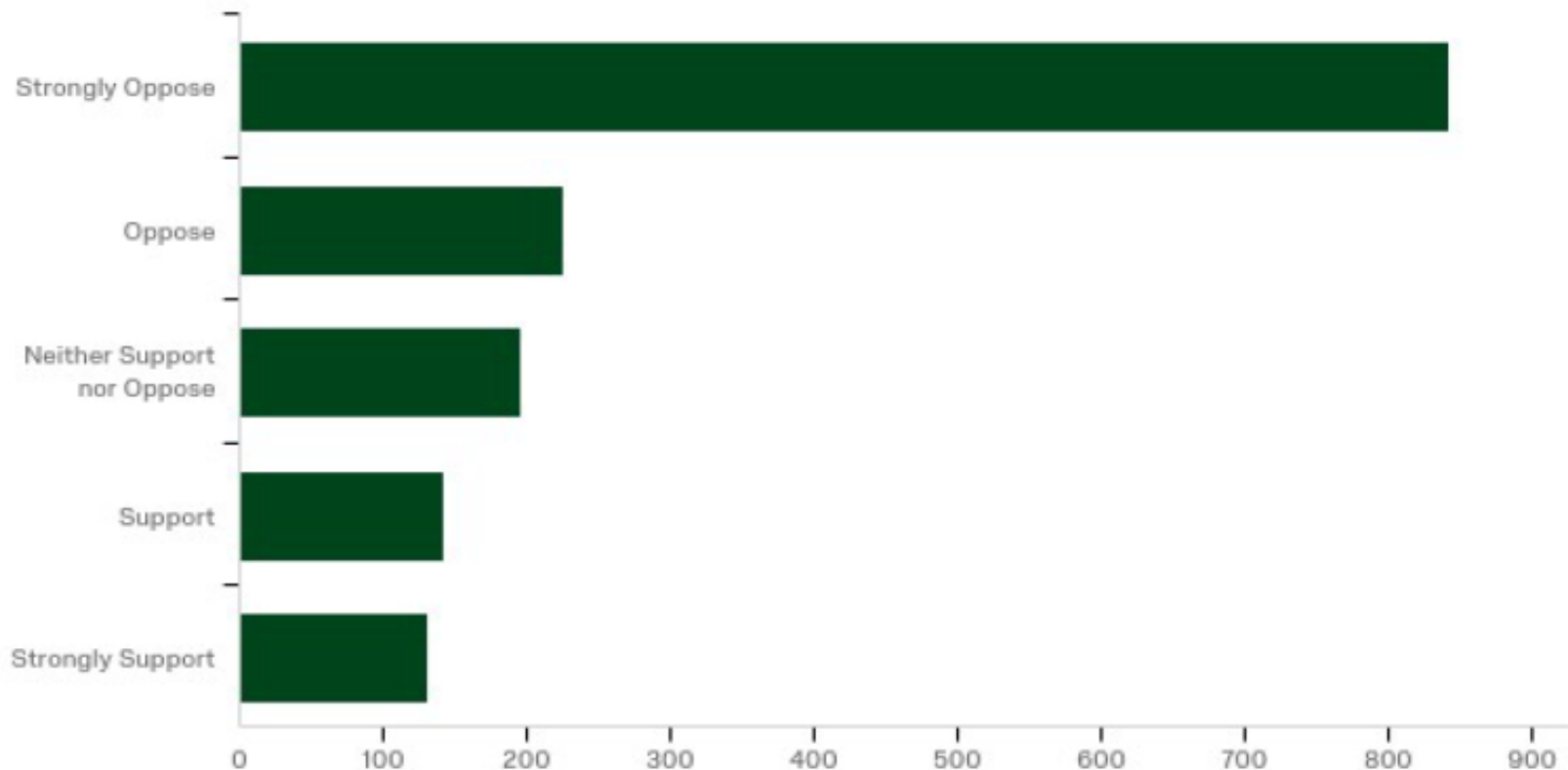


Q12 - For each of the proposed times listed, please indicate which of the following transportation options your child/children would most likely take. Select all that apply.

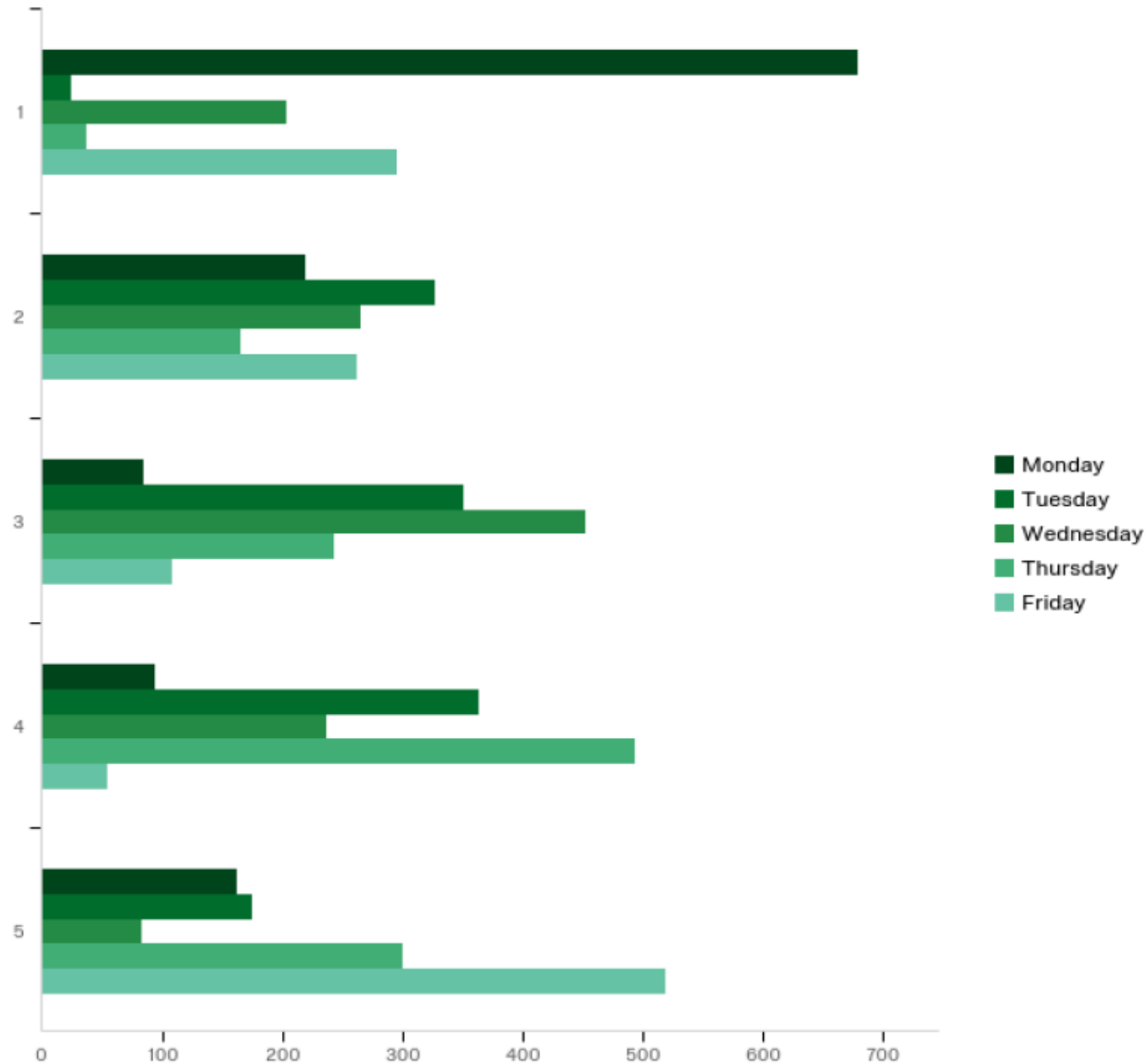


Q48 - Another way to provide students an opportunity to get more sleep would be to consider moving from an early release to a late arrival schedule.

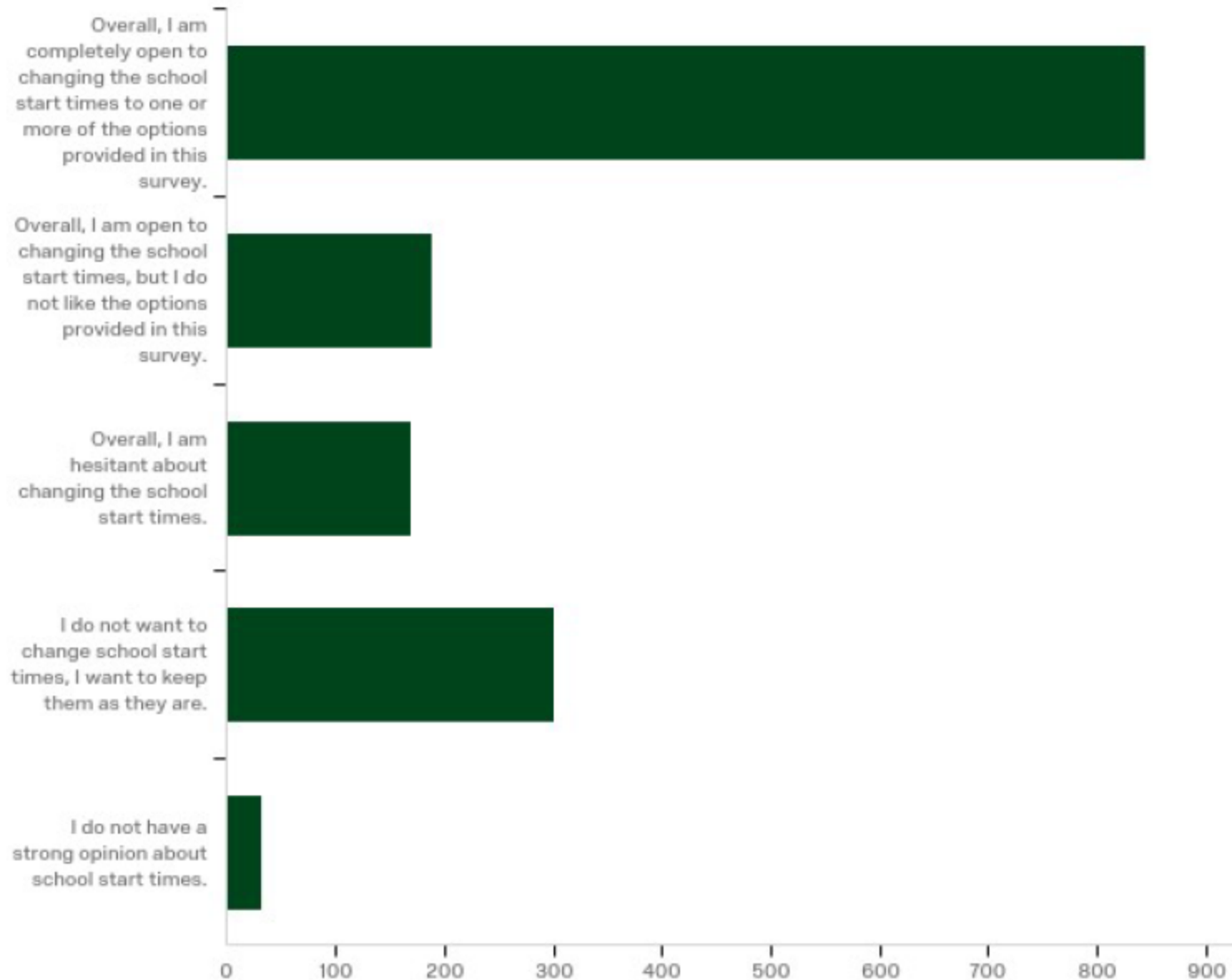
Please indicate to what extent you oppose or support changing an early release on Friday each week to a late arrival one day each week.

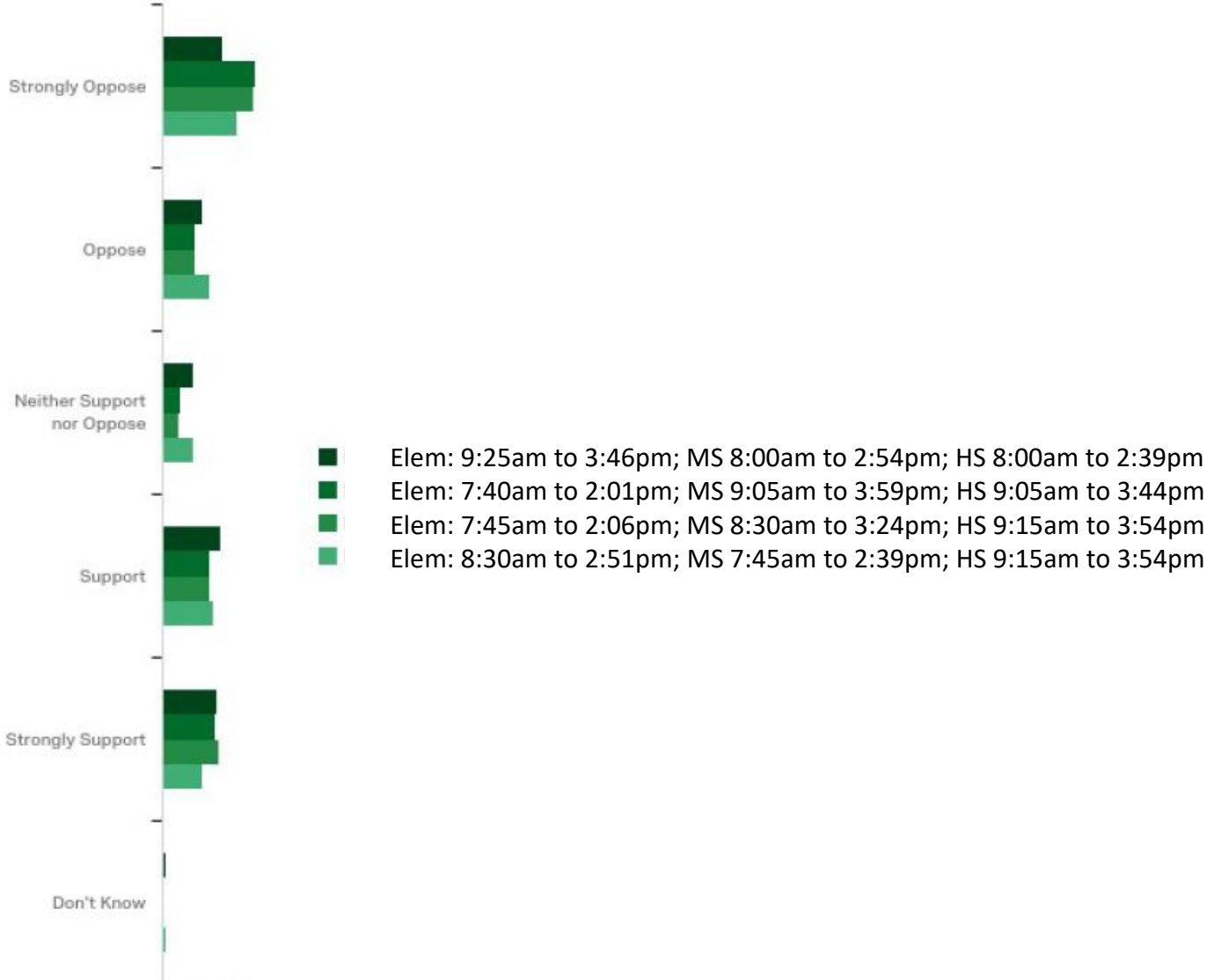


Q29 - Which of the following statements best reflects your thoughts on changing school start times:
