(Do NOT rely on communication from individual schools regarding weather-related closures or delays.)
- **District hotline:** 425-831-8494 Call to hear a recorded message.
- **FlashAlert.net:** Sign up for emails/texts of information sent to the media. (Download the free FlashAlert Messenger app or sign up online to receive the message sent to media when there's a school closure or delay.)
- Tune in to local TV & radio stations
- **District Facebook:** facebook.com/svsd410/ and District Twitter: @SnoqValleySD.

If there is no message regarding the Snoqualmie Valley School District, assume our schools are running on schedule. (We do not send a message stating schools are running on schedule.)

Also, the district plans to use the SchoolMessenger system to call/email/text ALL FAMILIES in our system – around 5:15 - 5:45 a.m. – when inclement weather necessitates a school closure or delay. Families who would prefer NOT to receive an early morning call from the Snoqualmie Valley School District may place their phone on “do not disturb” the night before. If schools are starting on schedule but “Limited Transportation” is needed, the district will email, text and post a notice on the district website, but will not disrupt families with a call-out.

NOTE: Since texting may incur a cost for users, parents/guardians/staff who want to receive texts from the district have to “opt in.” To allow text messages, address a text to 67587 on your smart phone, type “Y” or “YES” as the message, then hit send. (You can also opt out of text messages at any time by simply replying “Stop” to one of our messages.)
