Proposal

The Snoqualmie Valley School District is seeking proposals from the 2021 Small Works Roster for the construction of an animal barn at Mount Si High School, 8651 Meadowbrook Way SE, Snoqualmie, WA 98065. Proposals must include all services required to construct a barn used for seasonable high school animal program and add fencing to existing baseball backstop to create Three (3) animal paddocks. Barn is 980 sf w/ a 887 sf loft. The approximate area of work, including fencing, is 4,800 sf.

Other factors may be prior experience including past performance, technical qualifications, compatibility and interoperability with existing district equipment and training, or management capability. The district does not guarantee any award of contract by submitting an RFP. Incomplete proposals or those lacking required information will not be considered.
