Other opportunities to advance are explained on the <a href="#">Math Pathways Map</a></li> </ul> <p>Students will not be re-tested in math and will remain on their pathway unless an advancement request is approved. Advancement requests are considered by committee and decisions are primarily based upon end of year state testing results.</p>
<b>Language Arts</b>	<p>Students will be tested if a teacher or a parent or guardian nominates them.
