Dr. Rick Robins is the current Superintendent in Juab School District in Nephi, Utah. Dr. Robins has been in education for 22 years serving as a teacher, coach, and school administrator in four Utah school districts. Dr. Robins' leadership has helped establish Juab School District as a leader in competency-based education and personalized learning. In 2015, Juab School District was inducted into the Digital Promise League of Innovative Schools. These 90-member school districts nationwide are authorized by Congress and noted as some of the most innovative and forward thinking school models in the country. In 2018, Juab School District was honored at the National School Boards Convention in San Antonio, Texas by the Center for Digital Education as a Top 10 Survey Award Winner. As Juab High School Principal, Dr. Robins was awarded Utah's High School Principal of the Year in 2012 voted on by his peers.
